

RULES FOR LOANING A SHED KEY

1. The key is owned by Joensuun Kauhojat and it is loaned for a member in exchange for a deposit. Since the locking is digital, the key should be protected from water, when you go kayaking.
2. The key is meant for your personal use only, or the use of members living in a same household. The names of all the users of the key must be given.
3. The holder of the key is responsible for keeping his/her contact information up to date. If more than one member is using the same key, the contact information of all the persons must be kept up to date.
4. When you return the key, the deposit is paid back if the following conditions are met: the key must **function** and you have to **return it no later than at the end of the year when you resign or no longer pay the fees**.
5. After the time limit (see chapter number 4), the deposit is not returned. However, the club may buy the key back at a price of 15 euros.
6. If you don't pay the necessary fees yearly by the due date (April 15th), your access right is eliminated. The fees of all the users of a key must be paid by the due date.
7. A fee of 10 euros is charged about returning the access right, in case the holder of the key has not paid the fees by the due date.
8. The holder of the key is responsible about paying the fees by the due date and returning the key by the given time limit.
9. The holder of the key pays the costs about returning the key (for example the postage).
10. The holder of the key is responsible for the actions performed by a person whom the holder allows to enter the shed.
11. If the key is lost, please report it immediately in order to the access right to be eliminated. If necessary, **the access right is returned without cost**. If the key has not been found by the end of the year it went missing, the deposit is not paid back.
12. The access right may be eliminated if the holder uses the kayaks or gear against the rules.
